

ASHBOROUGH POOL INFORMATION AND RULES

Welcome to the Ashborough Pool. Please review the pool rules with your family in order to make the pool as safe as possible. By utilizing the pool facilities, you agree to abide by the rules.

POOL MAINTENANCE

Sweetwater Pools will provide daily maintenance of the pool area.. Sweetwater Pools is a certified pool operating company that maintains several pools in this area. If at any time you see a problem with the pool or the facility, please let the Pool Manager know or email Manager@Ashborough.org in order to resolve the issue.

SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK

Swim at your own risk allows swimmers access to the pool without the presence of an attendant. However, with this privilege comes responsibility. Solo swimming is not allowed.

No minor under the age of 13 is allowed to swim at own risk unless accompanied by a responsible person who is 16 years or older. See Rule 19.

First Offense: If a minor is found to be at the pool by a member of the Pool Committee or Ashborough Board without a responsible person who is at least 16 years old, the parent or legal guardian will be contacted and the incident documented.

Second Offense: If a minor is found to be at the pool by a member of the Pool Committee or Ashborough Board without a responsible person who is at least 16 years old, the minor will lose his/her swimming privileges for a week.

Third Offense: If a minor is found to be at the pool by a member of the Pool Committee or Ashborough Board without a responsible person who is at least 16 years old, the minor will lose his/her swimming privileges for the season.

POOL CLOSED

The pool is closed each night at 11:00 pm and will re-open at 5:00 am the next morning. If anyone is found in the pool during the pool closed hours, Dorchester County Sheriff's office will be contacted.

SWIM LANE

A designated swim lane is always provided for those wanting to swim laps during open swimming and swim team practice. Please be considerate of the person swimming laps and keep children and floats out of the designated swim lane.

POOL MEMBERSHIP AND GUESTS

MEMBERSHIP

Families that live in Ashborough must pay association dues to attend the pool.

RECREATIONAL MEMBERSHIPS (25 available each year)

Families that live in one of the Ashborough condominium communities must purchase a pool membership to use the pool and facilities.

Families that live outside of Ashborough may purchase a pool membership to attend the pool.

For new members wanting to join, the fee is the same as current year ACA dues.

Guests:

Six guests are allowed per family membership at one time. **Guests** are considered to live **outside** of Ashborough and both Ashborough condominium communities.

ASHBOROUGH ALLIGATORS

The Ashborough pool is the home of the Ashborough Alligators Swim Team. The pool closes at 4:00 pm on the evenings when a home swim meet is hosted.

ASHBOROUGH CIVIC ASSOCIATION - POOL RULES

DHEC MANDATED RULES

Rules are posted at the pool.

1. THERE SHOULD BE NO SOLO SWIMMING.
2. THERE SHOULD BE NO RUNNING, BOISTEROUS OR ROUGH PLAY.
3. NO PERSON UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL OR DRUGS SHOULD USE THE POOL
4. THERE SHOULD BE NO SPITTING OR BLOWING NOSE IN POOL.
5. PERSONS WITH DIARRHEA OR NAUSEA SHOULD NOT ENTER THE POOL.
6. INFANTS AND TODDLERS SHOULD WEAR SWIM DIAPERS TO ENTER THE POOL.
7. PERSONS WITH SKIN, EYE, EAR OR RESPIRATORY INFECTIONS SHOULD NOT ENTER THE POOL.
8. PERSONS WITH OPEN LESIONS OR WOUNDS SHOULD NOT ENTER THE POOL.
9. NO ANIMALS OR PETS ALLOWED IN THE POOL OR POOL ENCLOSURE.
10. NO GLASS ALLOWED IN THE POOL OR ON THE DECK.
11. NO CHILDREN SHOULD BE IN THE POOL WITHOUT SUPERVISION.
12. EVERYONE SHOULD TAKE A SHOWER BEFORE ENTERING THE POOL.
13. THE POOL IS OPEN FROM 5:00 AM TO 11:00 PM.
14. THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF SWIMMERS ALLOWED IN THE POOL IS 75.
15. AN EMERGENCY PHONE IS LOCATED OUTSIDE THE GUARD ROOM. (Messages will not be passed via the pool phone.)
16. A SAFETY DEVICE IS LOCATED ON THE WALL BETWEEN THE MEN'S AND WOMEN'S RESTROOMS.
17. THE LICENSED POOL OPERATOR AT THIS FACILITY IS SWEETWATER POOLS.
18. NO SMOKING OR VAPING WITHIN THE FENCED POOL AREA.
19. CHILDREN UNDER 13 MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY SOMEONE 16 OR OLDER.
20. POOL MEMBERS MUST BE PRESENT WITH THEIR GUESTS AT THE POOL OR RISK SUSPENSION. NON-MEMBERS WILL BE REPORTED TO DCSS AND WILL BE PUT ON TRESPASS NOTICE AND SUBSEQUENTLY ARRESTED IF FOUND AT POOL A SECOND TIME.
21. OFFENSIVE OR FOUL LANGUAGE WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.
22. PLEASE CONTACT THE ASHBOROUGH HELP LINE (843) 871-0077 IF YOU OBSERVE ANY INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR.

Swim Lessons

Swim Lessons may be offered at the pool by private Class A Ashborough residents in good standing. Any Class A resident in good standing may provide swim lessons to residents or non-residents during regular pool hours. No space will ever be reserved for swim lessons, nor does the Ashborough Civic Association endorse or manage any swim lesson programs. Acting as an agent for a for-profit business is not permitted.

The Ashborough Alligators swim coaches, as a supplement of their coaching duties, may also provide swim lessons to residents, families of current Ashborough Alligators and aspiring Ashborough Alligators.

Stroke and turn lessons may also be offered by the coaches outside of practices. No space is ever reserved for these lessons and are not endorsed or managed by the Ashborough Civic Association. Contact the swim team coordinators for more information.

Restrictions

No non-residents (including B members) may be allowed in our pool facility to provide swim lessons to non-residents. This is strictly PROHIBITED and constitutes a major liability issue.

Class A residents and B members may solicit outside swim lesson providers to provide “we come to you” services at the pool. These may be private or licensed swim lesson providers. Guest rules apply to this type of lesson. No space will be reserved for these lessons and are not endorsed or managed by the Ashborough Civic Association.

Violation of these rules may result in loss of privileges to the residents responsible for the key card.
